Free flu vaccine clinic available for all students

All Mitchell students, from public or private school, pre-kindergarten through high school, are welcome to attend a free vaccine clinic Nov. 4 (4-7 p.m.) at the Corn Palace. The vaccine will be offered to parents/guardians also, if they are accompanying a child.

Parental consent is required. Consent forms will be available for parents to fill out at the clinic. Parents can also print off a form for



the seasonal flu vaccine at <http://flu.sd.gov/child.aspx>.

Parents and guardians can fill these consent forms out ahead of time if they're unable to attend with their child. Forms may also be obtained from the Community Health Office at 115 W. 12th. in Mitchell.

Forms completed in advance and brought to the clinic will decrease time required for vaccination. Forms for the H1N1 flu vaccine will be available at a later date.

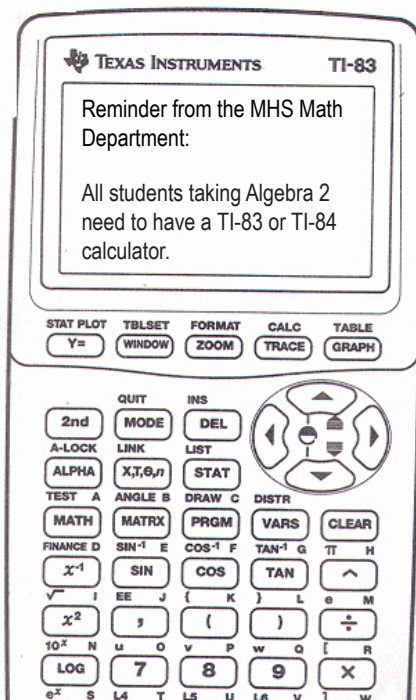

Parents, if you or your student would like to use a customized ACT preparatory curriculum, you are encouraged to check out the following website:

1. Go to www.bridges.com
2. Register by clicking on link on the left side
3. Enter Site ID code: 0105675
4. Enter Password: mitchell (all lower case)
5. Complete the "Brain Scan"

This program, entitled TestGear, is a unique opportunity for students to go online and engage in a brain-scan (it really isn't that

bad).

The result is a customized ACT test prep program based on the student's strengths and weaknesses. Also available on this website are tutorials to strengthen those areas of weakness- which is way cool.

Another tremendous resource on this site is two four-hour practice ACT exams. Once you complete a practice exam, you will receive immediate feedback on what your score is.
